

Amending a Proclamation proclaiming Land as a Road in Block II, Otahuhu Survey District, Mount Wellington Road District.

A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Land Act, 1924, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, General Sir Charles Fergusson, Baronet, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby amend the Proclamation dated the twenty-third day of September, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, No. 65, of the twenty-sixth day of the same month, proclaiming land as a road in Block II, Otahuhu Survey District, by inserting therein the following Schedule in lieu of the Schedule mentioned therein, which is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE.

LAND PROCLAIMED AS A ROAD.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land proclaimed as a road: 1 rood 20-16 perches.

Being road reserve adjoining Lots 59 and 60 on D.P. 15897, being portion Allotment 51, Section 12, Suburbs of Auckland, and portion Allotment 2, Section 2, Small Lots near Panmure.

Situated in Block II, Otahuhu Survey District (Auckland R.D.). (S.O. 25371.)

In the North Auckland Land District; as the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 76317, deposited in the office of the Minister of Public Works at Wellington, and thereon coloured red.

A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, General Sir Charles Fergusson, Baronet, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke so much of the Proclamation dated the twentieth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, No. 28, of the twenty-sixth day of the same month, taking land for a further portion of the North Auckland Main Trunk Railway (portions of Okoro and Rangiahua Sections) and for road-diversions in connection therewith and a road-approach thereto as affects the land described in the Schedule hereto, such land being incorrectly described.

FOR RAILWAY.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land affected: 13 acres 1 rood 10 perches.

Being portion of Section 13.

Situated in Block VIII, Mangamuka Survey District. (Auckland R.D.). (S.O. 24715.)
