

Notice making and levying Rates under the Swamp Drainage Act, 1915, and Amendments.

I, GEORGE WILLIAM FORBES, Minister of Lands, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by the Swamp Drainage Act, 1915, and its amendments, do hereby make and levy a rate to meet maintenance costs upon the unimproved value of all lands in the Waiki Drainage District liable to be rated in pursuance of that Act on a graduated scale as specified in the Schedule hereto according to the classification of the land.

The said rates will be payable in one sum on the 30th December, 1929, to the Collector of Rates at the Chief Drainage Engineer's Office, 5 Law Court Buildings, High Street, Auckland, at which office the rate-book will be open for inspection.

A copy of the rate-book may be inspected at the office of Mr. H. W. Earp, Clerk, Kaituna River Board, Te Puke, at all times at which that office is open for the transaction of public business.

SCHEDULE.

CLASS A: On the unimproved value of all lands classified as Class A by the arbitrators appointed under the said Act, seven pence and thirty-one hundredths of a penny (7d. and 31/100ths d.) in the pound.

Class B: On the unimproved value of all land classified as Class B by the arbitrators appointed under the said Act, five pence and sixty-nine one hundredths of a penny (5d. and 69/100ths d.) in the pound.

Class C: On the unimproved value of all lands classified as Class C by the arbitrators appointed under the said Act, three pence and twenty-five one hundredths of a penny (3d. and 25/100ths d.) in the pound.

Now, therefore, I, Ethelbert Alfred Ransom, Minister of Public Works, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by section 7 of the Main Highways Amendment Act, 1925, and of every other power in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby declare that the provisions of the said section 136 of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall apply in so far as affects the Eastern Bridge over the Waipa River at Otorohanga, on the Auckland-Wellington via Taranaki Main Highway, and the Western Bridge over the Waipa River at Otorohanga, on the Otorohanga-Honikiwi Main Highway.
