WHEREAS the Auckland Fire Board (hereinafter called “the said local authority”) is desirous of raising by way of bank overdraft the sum of three hundred and sixty pounds for the purpose of purchasing Lot 6, D.P. Number 17514, Allotment 24 of Tamaki West Farms, being whole of the land comprised in Certificate of Title, Volume 394, folio 296, in the Auckland Registry (area, 1 rood 17 perches), for the erection of a fire-brigade station :
