(b) Any authorized officer or officers of the Board may destroy all unbranded stock of any kind above the age of six months, or apparently above that age, found within the park.

11. REMOVAL OF CERTAIN PERSONS.

Any person who renders himself obnoxious by bad be haviour or disorderly conduct in the park may be summarily removed therefrom by the ranger or other officer of the

12. Dogs.

The ranger is empowered to destroy any dog found in the park, not being under proper control.
