HEREAS it is provided by section five of the Fisheries Act, 1908, that the Governor-General may from time to time, by Order in Council gazetted, make regulations, which shall have force and effect either throughout New Zealand or only in such waters or places as are specified in the regulations for, inter alia, imposing conditions and restrictions on the taking of fish, and prescribing in any part or parts of New Zealand a close season over any term not exceeding three

And whereas it is expedient to make certain regulations imposing conditions and restrictions on the taking of mussels in those waters of Whangarei Harbour hereinafter defined:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand in pursuance and exercise of the hereinbefore-recited power and authority, and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in that behalf, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby make the following

REGULATIONS.

(1) No person shall take or have in possession, for purposes of sale, mussels from the waters more particularly described in the Schedule hereto.

(2) It shall be lawful for any person to take mussels from the said area for home consumption only, but no such person shall take more than fifty mussels for such purpose in any one day.

(3) Any person committing a breach of these regulations shall be liable to a fine of £20.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that area of sea-bed bounded by a line commencing at the southern extremity of Busby Head and proceeding due west to the Marsden Point Beach; thence north-easterly and north-westerly along the line of ordinary high-water mark to the Marsden Point Wharf; thence by a direct line across the Whangarei Harbour to the southern extremity of Lort Point, Reotahi; thence generally easterly and southerly along the ordinary high-water mark of the Whangarei Harbour to the starting-point at Busby Head.
