It is centrally situated, and roads lead into it giving access to large areas of Crown and Native lands from Mokau, Ongarue, Lower Ohura, and Wanganui Rivers.

Deer to cease to be Imported Game in Buller Acclimatization District.

BLEDISLOE, Governor-General.

IN pursuance of the powers vested in me by the Animals Protection and Game Act, 1921-22 (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby declare that on and from the date hereof deer shall cease to be included in the Second Schedule of the said Act with respect to the Buller Acclimatization District, described in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

BULLER ACCLIMATIZATION DISTRICT.

ALL that area comprising the Buller and Inangahua Counties, bounded towards the north-west generally by a line starting at a point on the Tasman Sea coast at Kohaihai Bluff, in Block XIII, Whakapoai Survey District, and proceeding up a leading spur and along the summit of a range over Mount Domett to Mount Cobb; thence towards the north-east generally by a line along the summit of the western ranges over Mount Snowdon and Mount Peel to Mount Arthur; thence towards the south-east by a line along the summit of a leading range over Mount Luna and along the summit of Lyell Range to Bald Hill; thence by a line down a leading spur on the western side of Eight-mile or Boundary Stream to the mouth of that stream; thence down the left bank of the Buller River and up the right bank of the Inangahua River to a point due north of Mount Haast; thence by a right line to Mount Haast; thence by a right line to the
