National-endowment Land set apart as a Provisional State Forest.

A PROCLAMATION.

BY virtue and in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section eighteen of the Forests Act, 1921-22, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby set apart the national-endowment land described in the Schedule hereto as a provisional State forest.

SCHEDULE.

WESTLAND LAND DISTRICT.—WESTLAND FOREST-CONSERVATION REGION.

Part of Provisional State Forest No. 1622.

ALL that area of national-endowment land in the Westland Land District, containing 234 acres, more or less, situated in Block VI, Kanieri Survey District, and bounded generally as follows: Towards the north by Provisional State Forest No. 1622 (*Gazette*, 1920, page 2840), 4000 links; towards the

east by Provisional State Forest No. 1667 (*Gazette*, 1919, page 1288) 5550 links; towards the south by lines bearing 251° 30' for 800 links and 265° 30' for 3350 links; and towards the west by Provisional State Forest No. 1622 aforesaid, 6000 links. As the same is more particularly delineated on plan No. 125/43, deposited in the Head Office of the State Forest Service at Wellington, and thereon bordered red.

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, and issued under the Seal of that Dominion, this 23rd day of July, 1930.
