LOT 1 of Reserve 121B, Block V: Area, 239 acres 2 roods. Capital value, £880. Half-yearly rent, £17 12s.

The following improvements, valued at £147, are included in the capital value: Two-roomed hut (£75) and 144 chains of fencing (£72).

This section comprises about 70 acres open—grass and rushes, about 50 acres second growth; balance heavy bush.

About 112 acres rich sandy loam on gravel, with shallow bars through flat; ribbonwood and totara country; about 60 acres terrace and sidling, kamahi bush, few pines; poor soil. This section comprises about 5 acres open—rushes and grass; balance chiefly ribbonwood and miro, with patches of totara through it; rich silt deposit on gravel, shallow in totara bush.
