RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

Kahutara Stopbank Loan, £2,600, 1930

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Kahutara River Board hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest, sinking fund, and other charges on the Kahutara merest, sinking rund, and other charges on the Kanutara Stop-bank Special-rating Area Loan of £2,600, 1930, authorized to be raised by the Kahutara River Board under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of completing stopbanks for river protection, the said Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of nineteen thirty-seconds (19/32nds) of one penny in the pound sterling on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the Kabutara Stopbank Special rating District being more Kahutara Stopbank Special rating District, being more particularly described in the Schedule at the foot hereof, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five (25) years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
