A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke so much of the Proclamation, dated the twenty-eighth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, No. 9, of the fifth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one, taking land for afforestation purposes in Blocks X, I, V, VI, II, and IX, Gordon Survey District, and Blocks IV and VIII, Tadmor Survey District, as affects the land described in the Schedule hereto, such land being no longer required.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in him by the Municipal Corporations Act, 1920, the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby authorize the Lower Hutt Borough Council to permit the laying-off of the proposed streets described in the Schedule hereto of widths of less than sixty-six feet, but not less than forty feet and fifty feet respectively, subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the said streets within a distance of thirty-five feet from the centre-lines of the said streets.

SCHEDULE.

THAT proposed street in the Wellington Land District, Borough of Lower Hutt, containing by admeasurement 2 roods 7-14 perches, more or less, being portion of Section 4, Pitt Settlement, Block XIV, Belmont Survey District.
