#### BLEDISLOE, Governor-General. [L.S.] A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities Conferred upon me by section twenty of the Native Land Amendment and Native Land Claims Adjustment Act, 1921-22, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the areas of land described in the Schedule herete and more particularly delineated on the plan referred hereto and more particularly delineated on the plan referred to in the said Schedule, shall be deemed to have been duly ceded to the Crown by the Native owners thereof pursuant to the provisions of the said section twenty.
