WHEREAS the Hawke's Bay Rivers Board (hereinafter called "tho said local authority") is desirous of raising the sum of eleven thousand pounds pursuant to the provisions of section fifty-one of the Hawke's Bay Earthquake Act, 1931, by a loan to be known as "Earthquake Repair Loan, 1931," for the purpose of repairing damage to the Rivers Board's works, caused by the earthquake, including engineer's costs.

And whereas the said local authority has by Order in Council of even date herewith been declared to be a local authority for the purposes of Part II of the Hawke's Bay Earthquake Act, 1931:

And whereas the said local authority has complied with the provisions of the Local Government Loans Board Act, 1926 (hereinafter called "the said Act"), and it is expedient that the precedent consent of the Governor-General in Council under the said Act should be given to the raising of the said loan, on the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, and in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on him by the said Act, and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in this behalf, doth hereby consent to the raising by the said local authority of the said loan up to the amount of eleven thousand pounds, subject to the following conditions upon which the said loan may be consisted. so raised :-

- (1) The term of the loan shall not exceed thirty-five years.
- (2) The loan shall be free of interest for a period of five years from the date of the advance of the loan-moneys.
- The rate of interest thereafter payable shall be such rate or rates as shall not produce to the lender a rate exceeding the rate of four pounds per centum per annum.
- (4) The loan shall not be borrowed otherwise than on terms that the loan and the interest thereon shall be repaid by half-yearly instalments over a term of years (not exceeding thirty) calculated from the date on which interest first commences to accrue on any portion of the loan-moneys.
