

Adding an Outer Area to the Springs-Ellesmere Electric-power District.

A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the Electric-power Boards Act, 1925, and amendments, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby declare that from the date hereof the area described in the Schedule hereto shall be an outer area of the Springs-Ellesmere Electric-power District.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that area in the Canterbury Land District in the County of Halswell and Survey District of Halswell, bounded as follows: Commencing at the point where the eastern boundary of Block X, Halswell Survey District, meets the Ahuriri Road South, and proceeding thence generally in a northerly direction following the said eastern boundary of Block X and the eastern boundaries of Blocks VI and II, to a closed road formerly known as Burke's Bush Road; thence following the western boundaries of Rural Section 17737 to Burke's Bush Road North; thence in an easterly direction generally along that road to the eastern boundary of Halswell County; thence in a southerly direction generally following the eastern boundary of the said county to the point of commencement.
