

Declaring Waiteata Park, in the Borough of Gisborne, to be a Sanctuary under the Animals Protection and Game Act, 1921-22, East Coast Acclimatization District.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by section six of the Animals Protection and Game Act, 1921-22 (hereinafter referred to as the "said Act"), I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby notify and declare the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a sanctuary for the purposes in the said Act.

SCHEDULE.

WAITEATA PARK: All that area in the Gisborne Land District, bounded by a line commencing at the southernmost corner of Lot 48 on plan 1630, deposited in the office of the District Land Registrar at Gisborne; thence south-westerly along the north-western side of Richardson Avenue for a distance of 998.7 links; thence north-westerly along the north-eastern side of Russell Street for a distance of 500.7 links; thence north-easterly along the south-eastern boundaries of Lots 6 and 9 on plan 1747, deposited in the office of the District Land Registrar at Gisborne, to the south-western boundary of Lot 47 on plan 1630 aforesaid; thence south-easterly along the south-western boundaries of Lots 47 and 48, on plan 1630 aforesaid, to the southernmost corner of Lot 48, the point of commencement.
