RESOLUTION MAKING SECURITY RATE.

Extract from the Minutes of the Proceedings of a Meeting of the Christchurch City Council held on Monday, the 19th day of October, 1931.

Sydenham Waterworks No. 1 Redemption Loan, 1931, £12,550.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Christchurch City Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of twelve thousand five hundred and fifty pounds (£12,550), authorized to be raised by the Christchurch City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of redeeming the outstanding balance of a loan of fifteen thousand pounds (£15,000) raised on the 1st October, 1901, renewed on the 1st October, 1921, and maturing on the 1st October, 1931, the said Christchurch City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of ten-thousand-two-hundred-and-twenty-seven thirty-one thousand two hundred and fiftieths (10227/31250ths) of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property comprised within the Sydenham Waterworks No. 1 Loan 1901 Special-rating Area, the boundaries of which are described in the Schedule hereto, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty (20) years, or until the loan is fully paid off.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Christchurch City Council hereby resolves as follows:—
