THE Norwich and London Accident Insurance Association has given written notice to the Public Trustee, pursuant to the provision of the Insurance Companies Deposits Act, 1921-22,—

(1) That the Norwich and London Accident Insurance Association has ceased to carry on any class and all classes of insurance business in New Zealand within the meaning of the Insurance Companies Deposits Act, 1921-22, as from the 30th day of June, 1930, except as to policies or contracts granted or made before that date.

(2) That the Norwich and London Accident Insurance Association is merging with and is transferring its business to the Norwich Union Fire Insurance Society.

(3) That in all policies taken over on expiry from the Norwich and London Accident Insurance Association, the renewed policy will show that the Norwich Union Fire Insurance Society is the contracting party, and no policies will be renewed in the name of the Norwich and London Accident Insurance Association.

COPY OF RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE DUNEDIN CITY COUNCIL ON WEDNESDAY, 21ST JANUARY, 1931.

Resolution making Special Rate of $\frac{1}{2}$ d. in the Pound as Security for Loan of £30,400.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Dunedin City Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £30,400, authorized to be raised by the Dunedin City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of repaying the Roslyn Tramway Loan of £35,000, raised in the year 1921, the said Dunedin City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one half-penny ($\frac{1}{2}$ d.) in the pound (£) upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the City of Dunedin, comprising the whole of the City of Dunedin, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of May in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of fifteen (15) years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
