Amending a Proclamation setting apart Land as a Provisional State Forest.

#### BLEDISLOE, Governor-General. [L.S.] A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by a Proclamation dated the tenth day of V October, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine, and published in the Gazette of the seventeenth day of that month, page 2640 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Proclamation '), an area of national-endowment land containing four hundred and seventy-four acres, more or less, situated in Block III, Mawheranui Survey District, Westland Land District, was set apart as a provisional State forest in terms of section eighteen of the Forests Act, 1921-22:

And whereas two errors were made in the said Proclamation-viz., the area was not described as national-endowment

tion—viz., the area was not described as national-endowment land and the Forest number was shown as 1726 instead of 1730, and it is desirable that these errors be rectified:

Now, therefore, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section three of the Forests Amendment Act, 1925, do hereby amend the said Proclamation by declaring the land therein described to be national-endowment land and by substituting the Forest number 1730 for the number 1726.

#### SCHEDULE.

WESTLAND LAND DISTRICT .- WESTLAND FOREST - CONSER-VATION REGION.

Provisional State Forest No. 1730.

ALL that area of national-endowment land in Westland Land District, containing by admeasurement 474 acres, more or less, situated in Block III, Mawheranui Survey District, and bounded generally as follows: Towards the north by Section 3400, Block III aforesaid, and Provisional State Forest No. 1592 (Gazette, 1930, page 3124);

towards the east by Section 3303, Block III aforesaid. and by a line being the production of the eastern boundary of Section 3303 aforesaid; towards the south-east by the Grey River; towards the south-west by a line, being a production of south-east boundary of Section 2647, Block III aforesaid, and by Section 2647 aforesaid; and towards the north west by Section 51a, Block III aforesaid. As the same is more particularly delineated on plan No. 119/19, deposited in the Head Office of the State Forest Service, at Wellington, and thereon bordered red.

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, and issued under the Seal of that Dominion, this 27th day of January, 1931.

#### BLEDISLOE, Governor-General. A PROCLAMATION.

N pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section twenty of the Forests Act, 1921-22, f, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-Goneral of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting on the recommendation of the Minister of Lands, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto, being part of Provisional State Forest Reserve No. 1616, set apart by Proclamation dated the eleventh day of October, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, and gazetted on the fourteenth day of that month, is required for settlement purposes: and, in accordance with the provisions of the said Act, such land shall, from and after the day of the gazetting hereof, cease to be provisional State forest, and shall become subject to the provisions of the Land Act, 1924.

### SCHEDULE.

ALL that area in Westland Land District, being part of Provisional State Forest Reserve No. 1616, situated in Block IV, Kanieri Survey District, containing 457 acres, more or less, bounded as follows: Towards the north and north-east
