Public Prison at Wellington to be a Prison where Executions may take Place.

BLEDISLOE, Governor-General.

IN pursuance and exercise of the power and authority vested in me in that behalf by the fifteenth section of the Crimes Act, 1908, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby appoint the public prison at Wellington, in the said Dominion, to be a prison where executions may take place under the provisions of the said Act.
