A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by section twelve of the Land Act, 1924, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim as a road the land in Lower Hawea and Lower Wanaka Survey Districts described in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

APPROXIMATE areas of the pieces of land proclaimed as a road:—

A. R. P.	Being Portion of
10 1 18	Run 514, Block III, Lower Hawea Survey District, and Block V, Lower Wanaka Survey District; coloured blue.
5 2 9	Sections 20 and 21, Block IV, Lower Hawea Survey District; coloured red. (Otago R.D.)

In the Otago Land District: as the same are more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 82831, deposited in the office of the Minister of Public Works at Wellington, and thereon coloured as above mentioned.
