And whereas the Land Board of the North Auckland Land District has duly passed a resolution recommending that the whole of the remaining portion of the Ruarangi Kaurigum Reserve, as described in the Schedule heroto, be excepted from the operations of the Kauri-gum Industry Act, 1908, and it is expedient to give effect to such recommendation: Now, therefore, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon me by section one hundred and sixty-two of the Land Act, 1924, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, do hereby order and declare that the whole of the remaining portion of the Ruarangi Kauri-gum Reserve, as described in the Schedule hereto, shall, from the twenty-fourth day of February, one thousand nine from the twenty-fourth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-two, cease to be subject to the Kauri-gum Industry Act, 1908.
