A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes of a road; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the twenty-eighth day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-two.

SCHEDULE.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land taken: 1.1 perches. Being part Allotment 14, (D.P. 9587), Parish of Mangatawhiri. Situated in Block XIII, Opaheke Survey District (Auckland R.D.). (S.O. 26745.)

In the North Auckland Land District; as the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 83634, deposited in the office of the Minister of Public Works at Wellington, and thereon coloured red.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby declare the land described in the Schedule hereto to be Crown land subject to the Land Act, 1924.

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SCHEDULE.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land declared to be Crown land: 138 acres 3 roods 36 perches. Being portion of Section 14, Block XIII, and western part of Section 7, Block XIV, Rotorua Survey District. (S.O. 26506.)

In the Auckland Land District; as the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 83667, deposited in the office of the Minister of Public Works at Wellington, and thereon edged red.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land proclaimed as a street: 0.31 perches. Being portion of Lot 2, D.P. 1819, being part Allotment D, of Moturoa Native Reserve No. 1, Grey District.

Situated in Block IV, Paritutu Survey District (Borough of New Plymouth). (S.O. 7100.)
