A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by section twelve of the Land Act, 1924, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim as a road the land in Harataunga Survey District described in the First Schedule hereto; and also do hereby proclaim as closed the road described in the Second Schedule hereto.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

LAND PROCLAIMED AS A ROAD.

APPROXIMATE areas of the pieces of land proclaimed as a road:—

0 1 31-7	Paraoarahi Block; coloured red.
0 0 22-8	Whiritoa Block; coloured blue.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

All situated in Block VIII, Rangitoto Survey District (Auckland R.D.) (City of Auckland). (S.O. 26361.)

All in the North Auckland Land District; as the same are more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 83486, deposited in the office of the Minister of Public Works at Wellington, and thereon coloured as above mentioned.
