IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by section twelve of the Land Act, 1924, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim as a road the land in Newcastle Survey District described in the Schedule hereto.

APPROXIMATE areas of the pieces of land proclaimed as a road :--

A. R. P. Being Portion of 0 0 41 Part Allotment 104, Komakorau Parish (being 0 0 8.2 J land taken for camping-ground).

Situated in Block IV, Newcastle Survey District (Auckland R.D.). (S.O. 26512.)
