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Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred by section twenty-nine of the Inspection of Machinery Act, 1928, and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in that behalf, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby revoke the said Order in Council, and doth hereby make the following regulations prescribing the fees payable in respect of the inspections of machinery and boilers; and doth hereby further order and declare that the said regulation shall come into force on the declare that the said regulation shall come into force on the first day of May, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-two.

THE fees payable in respect of the inspections of machinery or boilers shall be in accordance with those prescribed in the Schedule hereto.
