RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Hawke's Bay Earthquake Act, 1931, and of all other powers (if any) it enabling, the Taradale Town Board hereby resolves as follows:

That, for the purpose of providing moneys required to repay a special loan of £2,500 (known as "Earthquake Rehabilitation Loan, 1931, No. 1"), and to pay the interest thereon at the rate of four pounds (£4) per centum per annum, which loan is authorized to be raised by the Taradale Town Board under the above-mentioned Acts for the purpose of repairing damage caused by earthquake on the 3rd day of February, 1931, to and the consequent rebuilding of the Taradale Town Hall, the said Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of five-sixteenths (5/16) of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property within the Taradale Town District, on the basis of the unimproved value, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, calculated from the rate during the currency of such loan, calculated from the date on which interest first commences to accrue on any portion of the said loan-moneys, and be payable yearly on the first day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, calculated from the date aforesaid, being a period of twenty-five (25) years from such date, or until the said loan is fully paid off.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and its amendments, the Wellington City Council hereby resolves as

amendments, the Wellington City Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of one hundred and seventy-one thousand four hundred pounds (£171,400) to be known as "The Wellington City General Improvements, Baths, Street Works, and Karori Works Renewal Loan, 1932," authorized to be raised by the Wellington City Council under the abovementioned Act for the purpose of redeeming the outstanding liability in respect of three loans of sixty-three thousand four hundred pounds (£63,400), fourteen thousand one hundred pounds (£14,100), and one hundred and five thousand one hundred pounds (£105,100), maturing on the 1st day of June, 1932, and in respect of one loan of seventeen thousand pounds (£17,000) maturing on the 30th day of June, 1932, the said Wellington City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of eighteen one-hundredths of a penny (18/100d,) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the whole of the City of Wellington, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and shall be payable yearly on the first day of July in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of fire (5) years from the first day of March, 1932, or until the every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of five (5) years from the first day of March, 1932, or until the loan is fully paid off.
