

towards the south-west generally by a line along the middle of the road forming the southern boundaries of Sections Nos. 285 and 284 to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary-line of Section No. 259, Block X aforesaid; thence to and along that boundary and its production to the middle of the Wainuioru River; thence by a line along the middle of that river to a point in line with the south-western boundary-line of Section No. 3, Block IX, Wainuioru Survey District; thence by a right line to the south-eastern corner of that section; thence by the south-western boundary-line and part of the western boundary-line of the said Section No. 3 to Section No. 5, Block XII, Huangarua Survey District, Mahupuku Settlement; thence by the southern boundary-lines of Sections Nos. 5 and 1, Block XII aforesaid, to the Whangaehu Stream; thence by the said Whangaehu Stream to the Whangaehu Road on the eastern boundary of Section No. 40, Block VII, Huangarua Survey District; thence by a right line bearing north 24° 29' west for a distance of 900.6 links; thence by a right line bearing north 24° 11' west for a distance of 163.8 links; thence by a right line bearing north 24° 5' 30" west for a distance of 225.8 links; thence by a right line bearing north 76° 28' west for a distance of 963.7 links; thence by a right line bearing north 57° 58' west for a distance of 651.8 links; thence by a right line bearing north 71° 12' west for a distance of 262.5 links; thence by a right line bearing north 71° 15' 30" west for a distance of 1298.7 links; thence by a right line bearing north 30° 55' west for a distance of 715 links; thence by a right line bearing north 11° 13' 30" east for a distance of 1175.1 links; thence by a right line bearing north 24° 51' 30" east for a distance of 297.1 links; thence by a right line bearing north 24° 57' east for a distance of 742.1 links; thence by a right line bearing north 15° 33' east for a distance of 1057.2 links; thence by a right line bearing north 0° 4' east for a distance of 1425.2 links to the northern boundary-line of Section No. 38, Block VII, Huangarua Survey District; thence by Sections Nos. 38, 61, and 60, Block VII aforesaid, and Section No. 58, Block VI, to the Ponatahi Road; thence by a right line across that road to the easternmost corner of Section No. 56, Block VI aforesaid; thence by the said Section No. 56 to the Pohaturiki Stream; thence by that stream to the Ruamahanga River; thence by a right line across the said Ruamahanga River to its right bank; thence by the right bank of that river to its confluence with the Waiohine River; thence by the right bank of the Waiohine River to its source near Mount Hector; and thence by a right line running due west to the summit of the Tararua Range; and thence towards the north-west generally by the summit of the said Tararua Range to the place of commencement, excluding therefrom the Borough of Carterton.

MAUNGARAKI RIDING.—WAIRARAPA SOUTH COUNTY.

ALL that area in the Wellington Land District bounded on the north-east, south-east, and south-west by the county boundary, and on the north-west by the Ruamahanga River from its confluence with the Waiohine River to its confluence with the Taueru River.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 27th day of April, 1932.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

HIS Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, and in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Weights and Measures Act, 1925, doth hereby make the following regulations for the purpose of the said Act.

REGULATIONS.

1. THESE regulations may be cited as the Weights and Measures Regulations, 1926, Amendment No. 3.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and be deemed to form part of the Weights and Measures Regulations, 1926 (hereinafter called "the principal regulations").

3. Regulation 2 of Part VII of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "other than", the term " $\frac{1}{2}$ cwt."

Additional Regulations under the Land and Income Tax Act, 1923, and Amendments.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 4th day of May, 1932.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section one hundred and seventy-two of the Land and Income Tax Act, 1923 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act"), His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby make the following additional regulations for the purposes of the said Act and the amendments thereof.

REGULATIONS.

1. ANNUAL returns of income shall be made under section 9 of the said Act by all companies and persons in business whether for the whole or part of the income year, and also by all persons in receipt of income from salary, wages, interest, rent, annuity, or other annual payments, where such income in conjunction with income from free-of-tax Government securities, company debentures issued free of tax, and from dividends or other profits derived from shares or other rights of membership in companies exceeds £200 per annum, whether such companies or persons are taxpayers or not, and shall be in the form No. 3 as prescribed in the regulations made under the said Act on the 14th day of April, 1930, or to the effect thereof.

2. Regulation 6 of the regulations made under the said Act on the 14th day of November, 1923, is hereby revoked.

3. Persons and companies in receipt of income which is assessable under section 4 (1) (a) of the Land and Income Tax Amendment Act, 1930, as amended by section 4 of the Land and Income Tax Amendment Act, 1931, shall render returns of such income on Part D of form No. 3 as set out in the Schedule to the regulations made under the said Act on the 14th day of April, 1930.

4. Persons and companies required to render returns under the provisions of Regulation 3 hereof shall also complete such other portions of the said form No. 3 as may in any case be applicable.

5. Form No. 5 as prescribed in the Schedule to the regulations made under the said Act on the 31st day of March, 1931, is hereby revoked, and the form No. 5 in the Schedule hereto is hereby substituted in lieu thereof.

6. All references in the regulations made under the said Act on the 14th day of November, 1923, to form No. 5 shall be deemed to be references to form No. 5 in the Schedule hereto.

NOTICE TO MAKE RETURNS OF INCOME UNDER THE LAND AND INCOME TAX ACT, 1923, AND AMENDMENTS.

NOTICE is hereby given that, in pursuance of the above Act and the regulations made thereunder, every person and company, whether a taxpayer or not, having derived income within the meaning of the said Act during the year ending 31st March, 19 , from any source or by any means which is made the subject of taxation under the said Act or any amendment thereof, is hereby required to make and furnish to me, in the prescribed form, returns of such income on or before the day of , 19 .

Returns of income are required to be furnished by all companies which, and persons who, whether for the whole or part of the income year, were in business, or in receipt of profits or gains derived from the use or occupation of lands
