WHEREAS by Order in Council dated the twenty-first day of February, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, and published in the *Gazette* of the third day of the following month, at page 601, Quintin Cosson and Arthur Henry Hersee Powell were licensed to use and occupy a part of the land between high and low water marks in Rangaunu Bay, in order to reclaim such land :

And whereas the said license was, with the consent of the Minister of Marine, transferred to Charles William Bloomfield Michie, and whereas it is now desirable to revoke the same :

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the south-western side of the portion of Regent Street (described in the Schedule hereto), within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of street.
