SOUTH PACIFIC OCEAN.

Winslow Reef, Doubtful Existence of.

Position: Lat. 1° 42′ S., long. 174° 50′ W. (approx.).

Details: The Note (P.D.) against the reef is to be replaced
by "E.D."

Remarks: Winslow Reef was discovered by the ship
"Pheonix" in 1851; it was reported to extend one mile in a

north-west and south-east direction and to be three-quarters of a mile wide, with two pointed rocks awash. In 1922, s.s. "Hauraki" passed over the charted position of the reef and saw no signs of shoal water. In 1928 s.s. "Nassa" and in 1932 s.s. "Golden Cross" passed over the charted position and saw no indication of a reef. In 1926, the "Doris Crane" passed about three miles northward of a coral reef or sandbank about a mile long in an east and west direction in lat. 0° 55′ S., long. 174° 51′ W. It is therefore considered that the existence of Winslow Reef in its charted position is doubtful, and it is possible that the reef is identical with that reported by the "Doris Crane."
