A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by the Discharged Soldiers Settlement Act, 1915, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke the Proclamations made on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, and the thirteenth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two, and published in the *Gazette* of the eighth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, and the nineteenth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two, respectively, setting apart lands for selection by discharged soldiers under the Discharged Soldiers Settlement Act, 1915, in so far as they relate to the lands in the Schedule hereto.
