*Order in Council varying the Term and Rate of Interest in respect of the Wairarapa Electric-power Board's Loan of £17,450.*

WHEREAS by Order in Council made on the fourteenth day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-two, and published in the *Gazette* on the seventeenth day of the same month, at page 545, consent has been given to the raising by the Wairarapa Electric-power Board of the Redemption Loan, 1932, up to the amount of seventeen thousand four hundred and fifty pounds, for a term of twenty-six years, at a rate of interest not exceeding the rate therein specified, and subject to the condition relating to the establishment of a sinking fund therein set out :

And whereas the said sum of seventeen thousand four hundred and fifty pounds has not yet been borrowed, and it is expedient to vary, as regards the borrowing of the said sum, the conditions of the said Order in Council relating to the term and the rate of interest at which the said loan may be borrowed :

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of New Zealand, acting by and with the consent of the Executive Council, and in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on him by section sixty-three of the Finance Act, 1932, and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in this behalf, doth hereby vary the conditions contained in the said Order in Council of the fourteenth day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-two, relating to the term and the rate of interest at which the said loan may be borrowed by imposing, in lieu of references to a term of twenty-six years and a rate of interest not exceeding five pounds five shillings per centum, conditions that the said sum of seventeen thousand four hundred and fifty pounds, or any part thereof, may be raised for a term of ten years at a rate of interest being such as shall not produce to the lenders a rate exceeding five pounds ten shillings per centum.

BY virtue of the powers and authorities vested in me by the thirty-fourth section of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act, 1928, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, do hereby order and declare that the reserve for recreation in the North Auckland Land District described in the Schedule hereto shall be and the same is hereby brought under the operation of, and declared to be subject to, the provisions of Part II of the said Act; and such reserve shall hereafter be known as the Selwyn Park Domain, and be managed, administered, and dealt with as a public domain.

SCHEDULE.

SELWYN PARK DOMAIN.

ALL that area in the North Auckland Land District, Borough of Dargaville, situate in Block XIII, Maungaru Survey District, containing by admeasurement 10 acres, more or less, being Lot 195 and Lots 226 to 245 inclusive, on a plan deposited at the office of the District Land Registrar at Auckland, and numbered 859; being a subdivision of part Kaihu No. 2D Block.
