WAIRARAPA ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Wairarapa Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows :—

That for the purpose of providing for the payment of the interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a loan of £17,450, authorized to be raised by the Wairarapa Electric-power Board under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of redeeming the outstanding liability over and above the amount of the accrued sinking fund in respect of a special loan of £20,000, borrowed by the said Board for the purpose of constructing hydro-electric works within the Board's district, the said Wairarapa Electric-power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-twentieth (1/20th) of a penny in the pound sterling upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the Wairarapa Electric-power District as defined in the First Schedule to the Proclamation proclaiming the said district, appearing in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the 25th day of March, 1920, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the said loan, and be payable yearly on the first (1st) day of September in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten years or until the loan is fully paid off.
