A PROCLAMATION.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by section twelve of the Land Act, 1924, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim as a road the land in Geraldine Survey District described in the Schedule hereto.

A PROCLAMATION.

I N pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes of a gravel-pit, and shall vest in the Chairman, Councillors, and Inhabitants of the County of Waikato, as from the date hereinafter mentioned; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the tenth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-two.

SCHEDULE.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land taken: 2 acres 1 rood 34.9 perches.

Being portion of Allotment 156, Hautapu Parish.

Situated in Block XII, Hamilton Survey District (Auckland R.D.). (S.O. 26642.)

In the Auckland Land District; as the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 84528, deposited in the office of the Minister of Public Works at Wellington, and thereon edged purple.
