(ii) Uncertificated sole or head teachers who are not holders of licenses to teach will be paid salaries according to the following scales: Grade I, £136/16/0-£162/9/0; Grade II, £171/0/0-£213/15/0; Grade III (a) or III (b), £213/15/0-£230/17/0; Grade III (c), £214/13/0-£247/1/0; Grade IV, £247/1/0-£271/7/0; with annual increments of £9* in every case, (iii) A deduction of £8/11/0 per annum shall be made from the salary provided above in the case of every uncertificated assistant teacher who is not the holder of a license to teach, except in cases of salaries of £55/11/6-£72/13/6 and £72/13/6-£89/15/6. (iv) The annual increments for head teachers shall be £13½*; and for assistant teachers shall be £13½* in the case of assistants receiving salaries of £141/1/6-£179/11/0, and £9* in every other case.
