Revocation of the Reservation of Portions of a Permanent State Forest.

A PROCLAMATION.

BY virtue and in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by the Forests Act, 1921-22, and pursuant to a resolution in that behalf passed by both Houses of Parliament, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke (so far only as it relates to the area of land described in the Schedule hereto) the Proclamation of the twenty-fourth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six, whereby the said land (with certain other land) was set apart as a permanent State forest, and declare that the reservation thereby effected is (so far only as aforesaid) revoked accordingly.

SCHEDULE.

SOUTHLAND LAND DISTRICT.—SOUTHLAND FOREST-CONSERVATION REGION.

ALL those areas in the Southland Land District containing 450 acres 2 roods 3 perches, more or less, and described as follows:—

All that area containing by admeasurement 198 acres 1 rood 33 perches, more or less, being parts of Sections 10 and 11, Block XXI, Jacobs River Hundred, part of the Pourakino Riverbank Reserve, and part of Ermedale Road, situated in Blocks XIII, XX, and XXI, Jacobs River Hundred, and bounded generally as follows: Towards the north-east by Sections 13, 14, and 16, Block XXI aforesaid, and Section 6, Block XX aforesaid; towards the north by Section 6 aforesaid and Section 29, Block XII aforesaid; towards the east by another part of Ermedale Road; towards the south by Sections 30, 31, 32, and again by Section 31, Block XIII aforesaid, and another part of the Pourakino Riverbank Reserve; towards the south-west by the Pourakino River; and towards the north-west by another part of Section 10 aforesaid.
