SCHEDULE.

NORTH AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT.—AUCKLAND FOREST-CONSERVATION REGION.

ALL those areas in the North Auckland Land District, containing by admeasurement 12,564 acres 0 roods 18 perches, more or less, and described as follows:—

All that area, containing by admeasurement 1,150 acres, more or less, being Provisional State Forest No. 86 (*Gazette*, 1920, page 3138—ordinary provisional State forest), situated in Block VIII, Waipoua Survey District, and bounded generally as follows: Towards the east by Sections, 23, 13, and 30, Block VIII aforesaid, and the Waima River; towards the south by Sections 31 and 25, Block VIII aforesaid; and towards the west and north-west by a public road.
