IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes of a road; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the sixth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three. day of February, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three

W HEREAS the Land Board of the Westland Land District has recommended that the Crown tenant of the land enumerated in the Schedule hereto should be afforded relief, owing to exceptional circumstances over which he has no control preventing the profitable occupation of such land:

Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon me by section one hundred and thirty-four of the Land Act, 1924, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand,

do hereby proclaim and declare the land enumerated in the Schedule hereto to be subject to the provisions of section one hundred and thirty-three of the Land Act, 1924; and I do further fix three years from the date mentioned in the said Schedule as the period for which the said land shall be exempt from payment of rent and general rates.

Revoking the Setting-apart of Land for Selection by Dis-charged Soldiers, under Special Tenures, in the North Auckland Land District.

A PROCLAMATION.

I N pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by the Discharged Soldiers Settlement Act, 1915, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke the Proclamation made on the twenty-second day of April, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, and published in the Gazette of the twenty-ninth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, setting apart lands for selection by discharged soldiers under the Discharged Soldiers Settlement Act, 1915, in so far as it relates to the land in the Schedule hereto.
