RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

Extract from the minutes of proceedings of the Franklin County Council at a meeting of such Council held on the 26th day of April, 1933.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and of all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Franklin County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purposes of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of four hundred and fifty pounds (£450), authorized to be raised by the Franklin County Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of metalling Lewis Road, Karaka, the said Franklin County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one half-penny ($\frac{1}{2}$ d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property of the Lewis Road (Karaka) Special Rating Area, being part of Karaka Riding of the County of Franklin, and being more particularly described in the Schedule hereto, and that such special rate shall be an annual recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of July in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty (20) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
