A PROCLAMATION.

BY virtue and in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section eighteen of the Forests Act, 1921-22, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby set apart the Crown land described in the Schedule hereto as a permanent State forest.

SCHEDULE.

AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT.—ROTORUA FOREST-CONSERVATION REGION.

(Part of Kaingaroa Plantation.)

ALL those areas in the Auckland Land District, containing together 2 roods 13-9 perches, more or less, and described as follows:—

All that area containing by admeasurement 11-5 perches, more or less, situated in Block X, Kaingaroa Survey District, and bounded generally as follows: Towards the north-east and south-east by a State forest (*Gazette*, 1911, page 3567); and towards the south-west by a public road.

Also all that area containing by admeasurement 2 roods 2-4 perches, more or less, situated in Blocks X and XIV, Kaingaroa Survey District, and bounded generally as follows: Towards the north-east by a public road; towards the south-east and again towards the north-east by a State forest (*Gazette*, 1911, page 3567); again towards the north-east by a public road; and towards the south-west and north-west by the aforesaid State forest.

As the same are more particularly delineated on plan No. 47/34, deposited in the Head Office of the State Forest Service, at Wellington, and thereon coloured green. (Auckland Plan S.O. 26818.)

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, and issued under the Seal of that Dominion, this 21st day of June, 1933.
