Cancelling the Reservation over a Primary-education Endowment in the Wellington Land District, and reserving Crown Land in lieu thereof.

W HEREAS by section one hundred and sixty-three of the Land Act, 1924, it is enacted that the Governor-General may, by Warrant under his hand, whenever he deems it expedient in the public interest so to do, cancel the reservation over any education reserve or endowment vested in the Crown, or over any part thereof, and to reserve in lieu thereof either an area of equal value of national-endowment land over which the reservation has likewise been cancelled pursuant to that section or an area of equal value of ordinary Crown land:

And whereas the Governor-General deems it expedient in

the public interest to cancel the reservation over the primary education reserve described in the First Schedule hereto, and to reserve in lieu thereof the area of Crown land of equal

value described in the Second Schedule hereto:

Now, therefore, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, GovernorGeneral of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section one hundred and sixty-three of the Land Act, 1924, do hereby cancel the reservation over the primary-education reserve described in the First Schedule hereto, and do hereby reserve in lieu thereof the Crown land of equal value described in the Second Schedule hereto.
