APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE FOR A WATER-RACE.

To the Warden of the Westland Mining District, at Murchison.

Length and intended course of race: Ten miles; trending generally north.

Points of intake: On Sheriff River, Block VIII, Rahu Survey District, intake point, Scenic Reserve No. 9.

Estimated time and cost of construction: Eight months; £750.

Mean depth and breadth: 5 ft. by 3 ft.

Number of heads to be diverted: Forty-five sluice-heads.

Purpose for which water is to be used: Sluicing wash-terraces for gold.

Proposed term of license: Twenty years.
