ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 8th day of September, 1933.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on him by section sixty-six of the Hawke's Bay Earthquake Act, 1931, and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby make the following regulations for the purposes of the said Act.

REGULATIONS.

1. THESE regulations may be cited as the Napier Harbour Board (Finance) Regulations, 1933, and the Napier Harbour Board is hereinafter referred to as "the Board."

2. The Board is hereby authorized to use the unexpended balance of twenty-three thousand six hundred pounds (£23,600), being portion of the loan of two hundred and forty-seven thousand one hundred pounds (£247,100) more particularly described in the Napier Harbour Board Empowering Loan and Constitution Amendment Act, 1927, for the purpose of carrying out in whole or in part such harbour or other works as are specifically shown and described in the Schedule hereto.
