"Separate consignments of goods shall be computed separately, and computing the whole of one firm's or person's consignments in the lump or as a whole as one consignment shall not be allowed, saving and excepting that when any firm or person ships or receives more than one package of goods on any one day by the same ship, then wharfage shall be charged on the total measurement of all the packages, and not separately.

BY virtue of the powers and authorities vested in me by subsection two of section one hundred and one of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act, 1928, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, do hereby order and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto, being portion of a forest and scenery reserve, shall from and after the day of the gazetting hereof become subject to the Coal-mines Act, 1925, as if it were Crown land as defined by such last-mentioned Act.
