IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers in any-wise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby grant to Gilbert Charles Wells, Farmer Dominion, doth hereby grant to Gilbert Charles Wells, Farmer (hereinafter with his successors and assigns referred to as "the licensee'), a license, subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth, to take and use from a stream (hereinafter referred to as "the said stream") situated on Section 2, Block VIII, French Pass Survey District, in the Nelson Land District, for the purposes hereinafter set forth, a stream of water (hereinafter referred to as "the said water") not exceeding one-twentieth of a cubic foot per second at any one time; and also to lay, construct, put up, place, and use the electric lines hereinafter desoribed on the conditions hereinafter set forth: Provided that nothing herein shall be held to guarantee that the said that nothing herein shall be held to guarantee that the said stream contains sufficient water to supply the volume of water hereinbefore referred to; and all rights hereby granted shall be subject to all existing rights heretofore granted under the Mining Acts or otherwise.

3. Utilization of the Water.
