

## PRIVATE BILL.

*Conversion Loan, 1934.*

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by Part II of the Local Authorities Interest Reduction and Loans Conversion Act, 1932-33, and the Lower Hutt Borough Loans Conversion Order, 1934, the Lower Hutt Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest, sinking fund, and other charges on the new securities authorized to be issued by the Lower Hutt Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act and Order in conversion of existing securities issued in respect of the loans set out in the First Schedule to that Order, and also the interest, sinking fund, and other charges on the unconverted securities issued in respect of such loans, the said Lower Hutt Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of  $1\frac{3}{4}\frac{3}{4}$  of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of unimproved value) of all rateable property of the district, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such securities and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year until the last maturity date of such securities, being the 1st day of March, 1962, or until all such securities are fully paid off.”
