Woodville-Palmerston North Main Highway By-laws.

W HEREAS by section 9 of the Main Highways Act, 1922 (hereinafter called "the said Act"), the powers, rights, duties, and liabilities vested in or imposed on the Governor-General or Minister of Public Works (in the case of Government roads), or vested in or imposed on any local authority (in the case of highways other than Government roads), are, in the case of main highways, transferred to and vested in or imposed on the Main Highways Board (hereinafter called "the said Board"): called "the said Board "):

vested in of imposed on the name tighways board (necessaries) called "the said Board "): And whereas by authority of the said Act and of the Motor-vehicles Act, 1924, and of all other powers in anywise enabling it in that behalf, the Board made on the 22nd day of April, 1926, and on the 20th day of May, 1926, by-laws which were published in the *Gazette* dated the 4th day of June, 1926, in respect of that portion of the Woodville-Palmerston North Main Highway from the eastern boundary of the County of Pahiatua to the eastern boundary of the County of Oroua (better known as the Manawatu Gorge Boad): And whereas the Board by a resolution duly passed at a meeting held at Wellington on the 20th day of June, 1934, decided that such by-laws should be revoked: Now, therefore, the said Board, acting by authority of the said Act, and of the Motor-vehicles Act, 1924, and of all other powers in anywise enabling it in this behalf, doth hereby revoke the aforementioned by-laws as from the date of publication of this notice in the *Gazette*.
