A PROCLAMATION.

BY virtue and in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section eighteen of the Forests Act, 1921-22, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby set apart the Crown land described in the Schedule hereto as part of a provisional State forest.

SCHEDULE.

WESTLAND LAND DISTRICT.—WESTLAND FOREST-CONSERVATION REGION.

ALL that area of Crown land in the Westland Land District, containing by admeasurement 52 acres, more or less, situated in Block V, Totara Survey District, and bounded as follows: Commencing at a point on the western boundary of Block V, Totara Survey District, 884 links due north of Reserve 210, Ross Borough Endowment; thence running $21^{\circ} 9'$ for 5553.4 links; thence 270° for 2003.7 links; and thence 180° for 5179.3 links to the point of commencement. As the same is more particularly delineated on plan No. 132/21, deposited in the Head Office of the State Forest Service at Wellington, and thereon bordered green.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the Scenery Preservation Board, constituted pursuant to the Scenery Preservation Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act"), has recommended that the land described in the Schedule hereto should be permanently reserved for scenic purposes, and it is expedient to give effect to such recommendation:

Now, therefore, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto shall be a scenic reserve under the said Act, and subject to the provisions thereof.

SCHEDULE.

ALL those pieces or parcels of land in the Wellington Land District, containing by admeasurement 9 acres 0 roods 4.1 perches, more or less, being parts of Lot 2, D.P. 3449, part of the Hapopo Block, situated in Block VI, Ongo Survey District. As the same are more particularly delineated on the plan marked 61/36, deposited in the Wellington District Office, Department of Lands and Survey, and thereon bordered green.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by section three hundred and two of the Land Act, 1924, as amended by section ten of the Land Laws Amendment Act, 1926, it is enacted that on the disposal of any national-endowment land by way of sale, or on the acquisition of the fee-simple of any such land, the Governor-General may by Proclamation declare that such land shall, as from a date to be specified in the Proclamation, cease to be national-endowment land:

And whereas the land described in the Schedule hereto has been disposed of by way of sale for cash and it is expedient that the said land should cease to be national-endowment land:

Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by the aforesaid section three hundred and two of the Land Act, 1924, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto, which was set apart as national-endowment land under the provisions of section two hundred and fifty-eight of the Land Act, 1908, ceased to be national-endowment land as from the twelfth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section three of the Discharged Soldiers Settlement Amendment Act, 1919, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke the Proclamation made on the twenty-seventh day of November, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, and published in the *Gazette* of the first day of December then instant, setting apart lands for selection by discharged soldiers under the Discharged Soldiers Settlement Act, 1915, in so far as it relates to the land in the Schedule hereto.
