(2) A jetty, extending 250° for 214 ft. from a position 306° 70 yards from the water-tower northward of the Railway Workshop at the Mount, has been erected for the use of small

Two fixed lights, red over white, visible 2 miles, are exhibited from the outer end of the jetty at heights of 25 ft. and

The lights are visible from 358° through east to 133°.

These bearings pass through No. 2 black buoy and the concrete jetty in Pilot Bay.

(3) No. 2 red buoy is now No. 3, and has been moored in 18 ft. M.L.W.S. in a position 250° 270 yards from the end of the jetty in (2).

(4) The flashing light in Whareroa beacon has been discontinued. The beacon now carries a black cage surmount.
