Registered Medical Practitioner prohibited from issuing Prescriptions for dispensing Dangerous Drugs.

PURSUANT to the provisions of Regulation 11 of the Dangerous Drugs Regulations, dated the 24th day of September, 1928, and appearing in the *New Zealand Gazette* published on the 27th day of September, 1928, at page 2873, I, James Alexander Young, Minister of Health, on the recommendation of the Medical Council, hereby prohibit Graham Campbell MacDiarmid, registered medical practitioner, of Russell, from issuing prescriptions for the dispensing of dangerous drugs.

Prohibition of Issue of Money-orders and Transmission of Postal Correspondence.
