N accordance with the provisions of the Education Act, 1914, and with the powers thereunder, I, Sydney George Smith, Minister of Education, do hereby approve of the following amendments of the scheme of control of the Otago Boys' and Girls' High Schools.

AMENDMENTS OF SCHEME OF CONTROL.

The scheme of control, approved and gazetted as shown in the Schedule hereto, is hereby further amended-

- 1. As to clause 2, subclause (3), by deleting the words "at the end of the term preceding the closing of the roll" from the definition of a "pupil of the school."
 - 2. As to clause 3, subclause (1), by adding the proviso-

"Provided that the Board may in its discretion decide that an election to fill a casual vacancy be not held if such vacancy occurs after the month of February in a year in which an ordinary election is held and before the persons elected at such ordinary election assume office.
