A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section eight of the Mining Act, 1926, and of every other power and authority enabling me in this behalf, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby as from the date of the publication hereof in the *New Zealand Gazette* alter the boundaries of the Otago Mining District by including therein all that area of land described in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that area in the Otago Land District, containing by admeasurement 35 acres, more or less, being Section 3, Block XIX, and part of the Town Belt, Town of Alexandra: Bounded towards the north-west by River-bank Reserve and Section 84, Block VII, Leaning Rock Survey District, 3780 links; towards the north-east by other part of Town Belt, 1050 links; towards the south-east by Section 9, Block XXXV, Sections 1 and 2, Block XIX, the abuttal of a public road and Crown lands, 3340 links; and towards the south-west by the Clutha River, 1150 links; be all the aforesaid linkages more or less.
